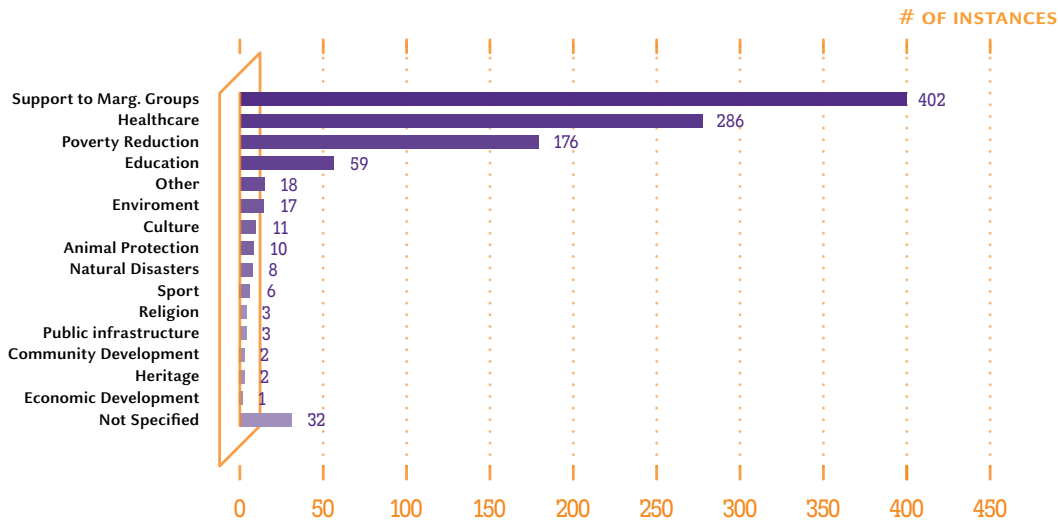

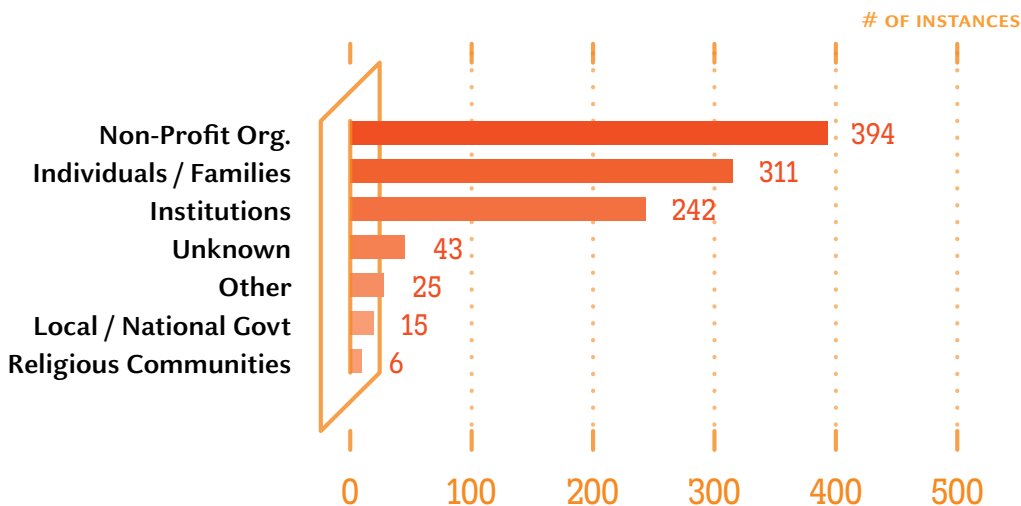

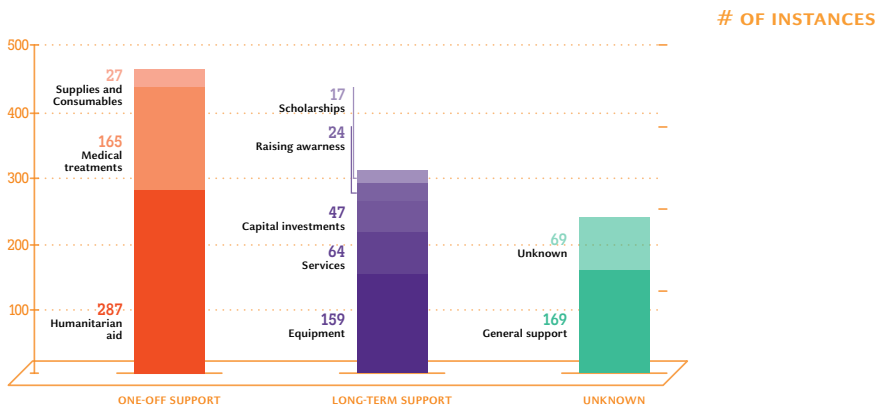

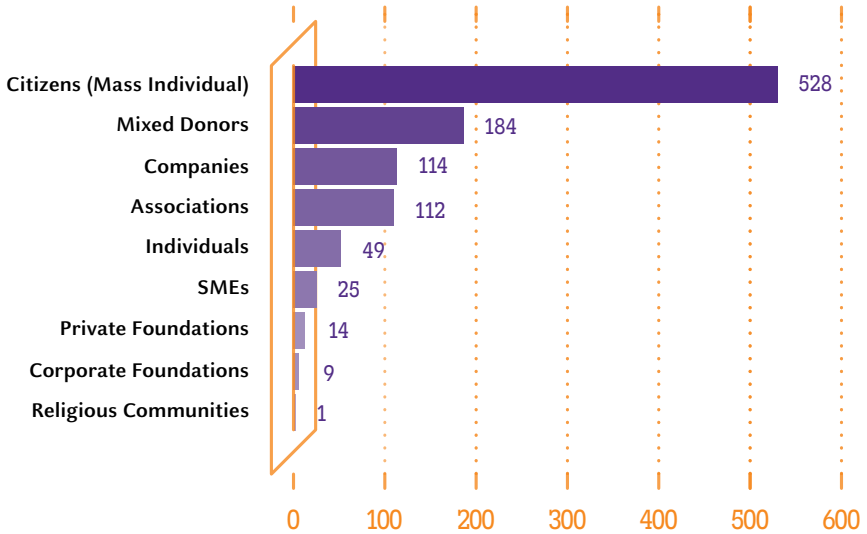

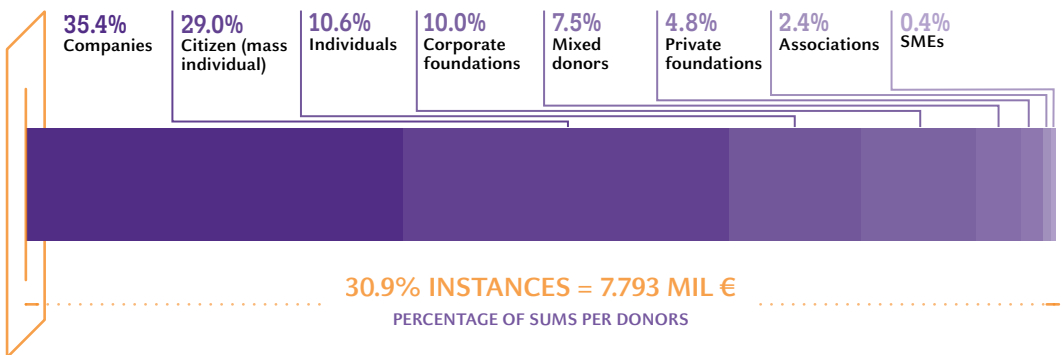
Use of Donations
