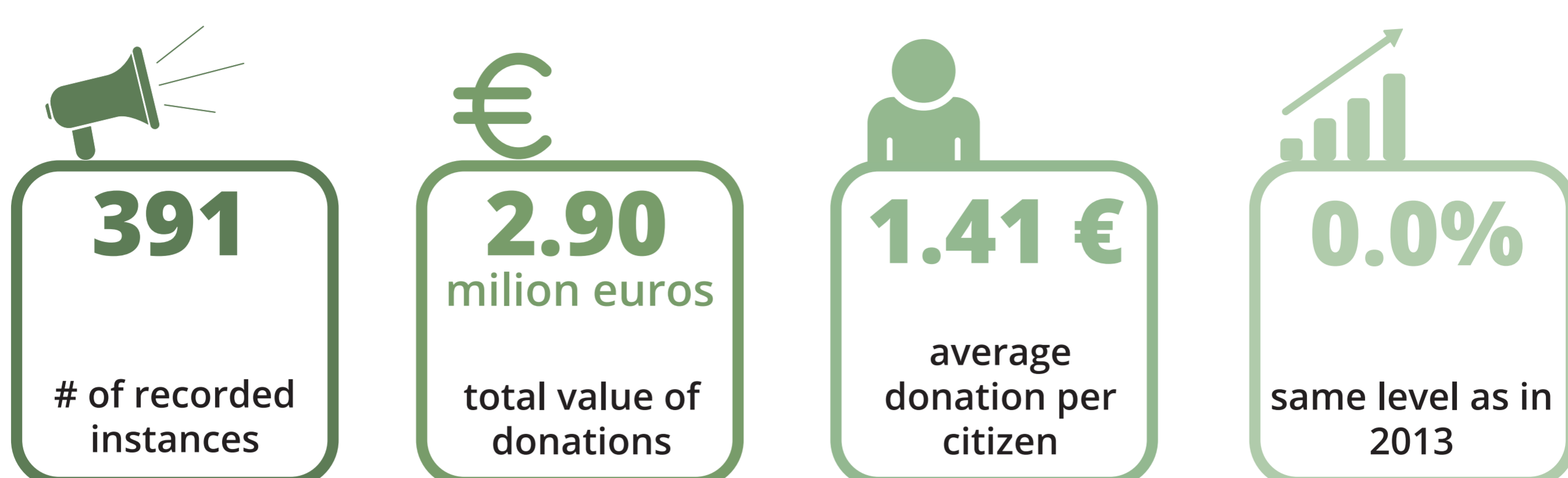

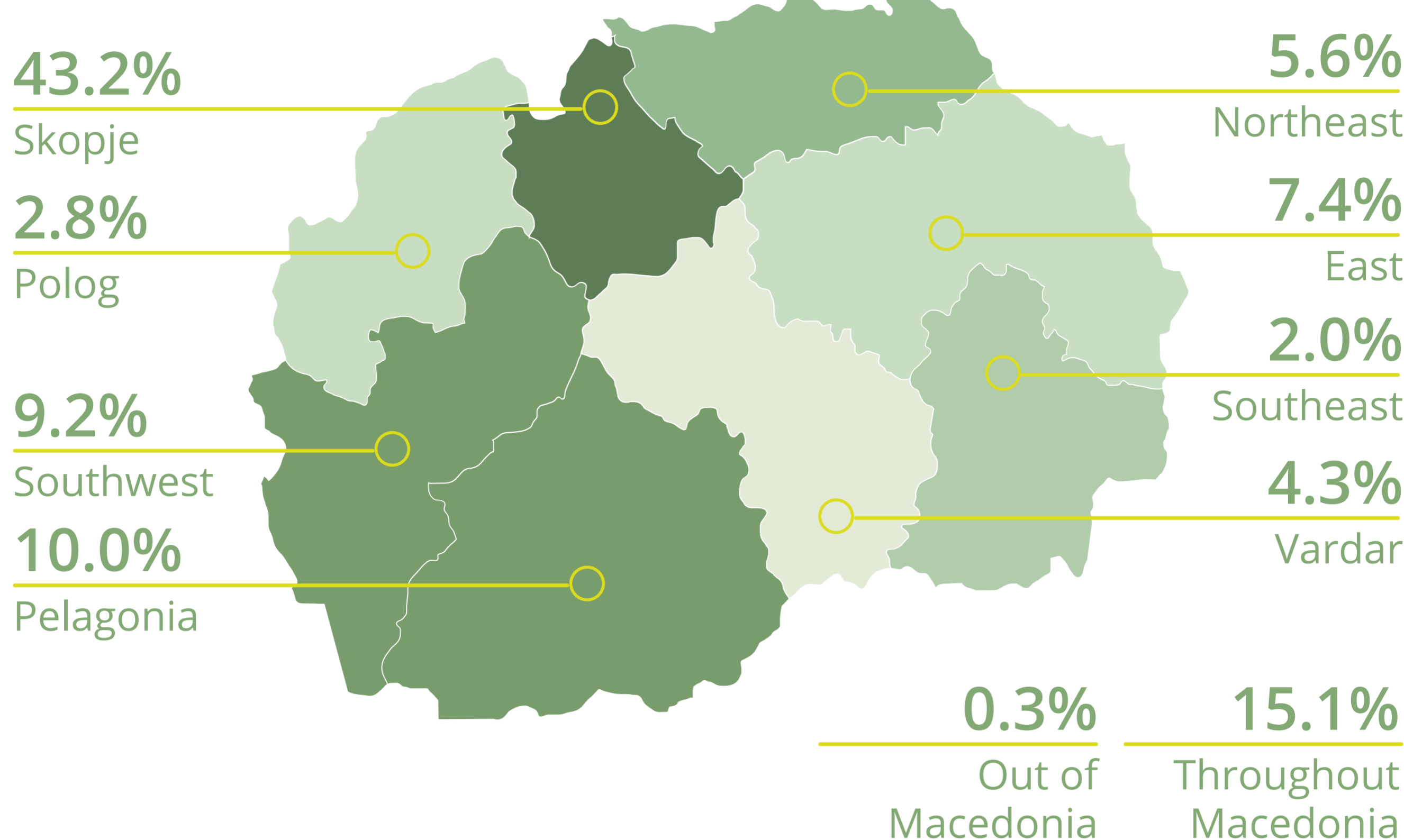

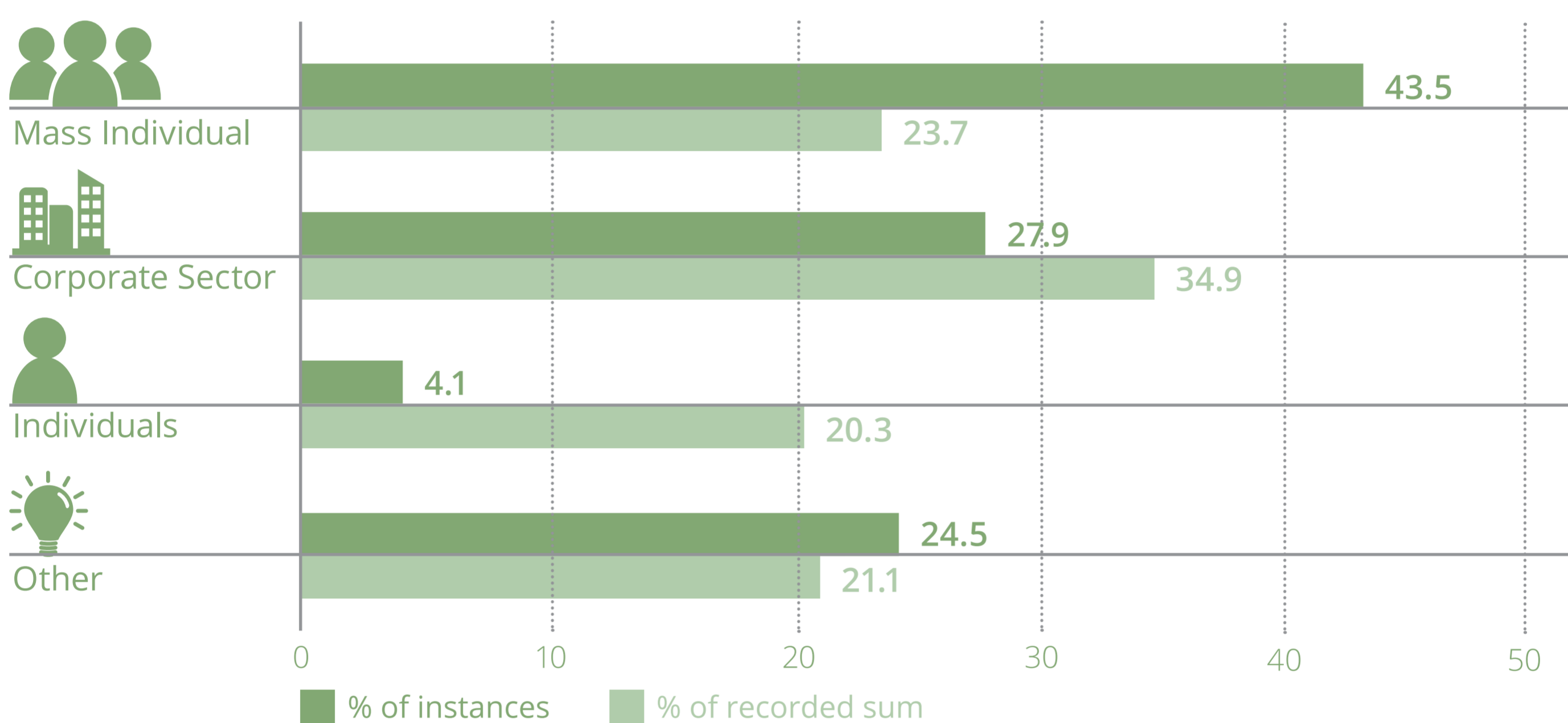


## GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

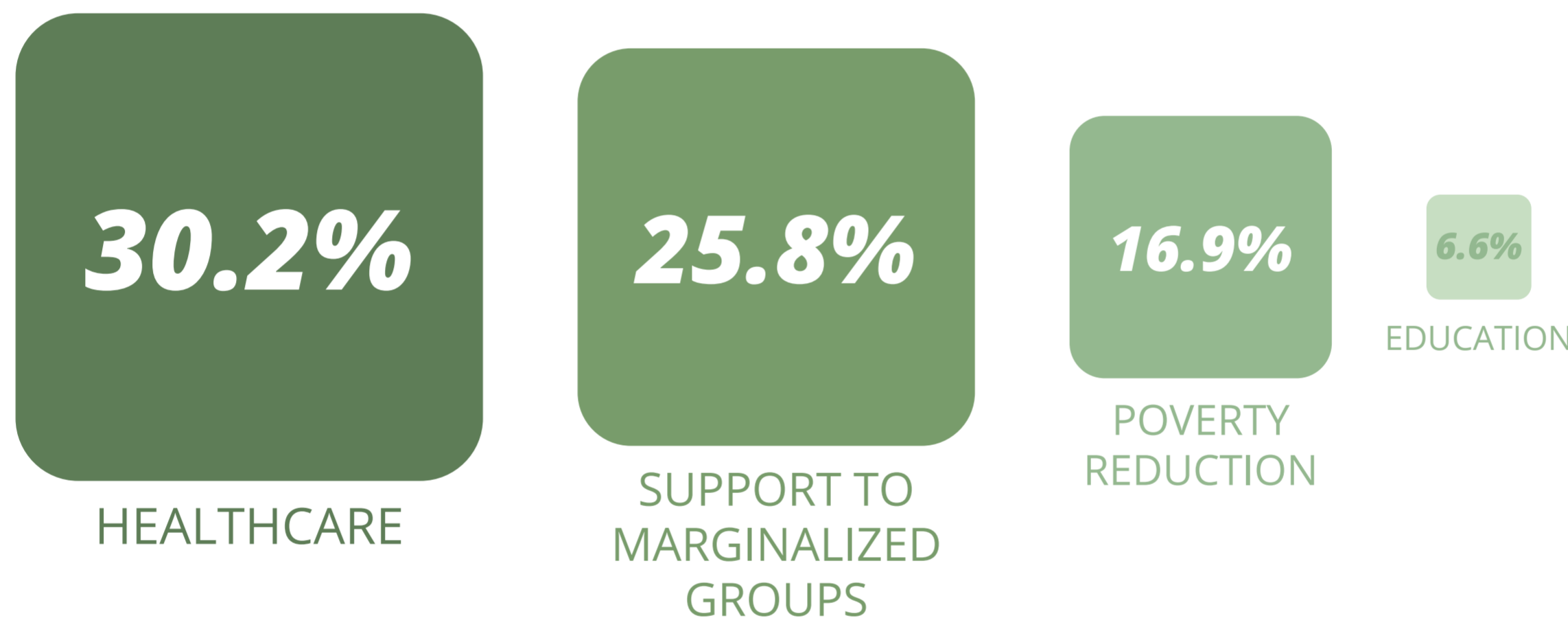

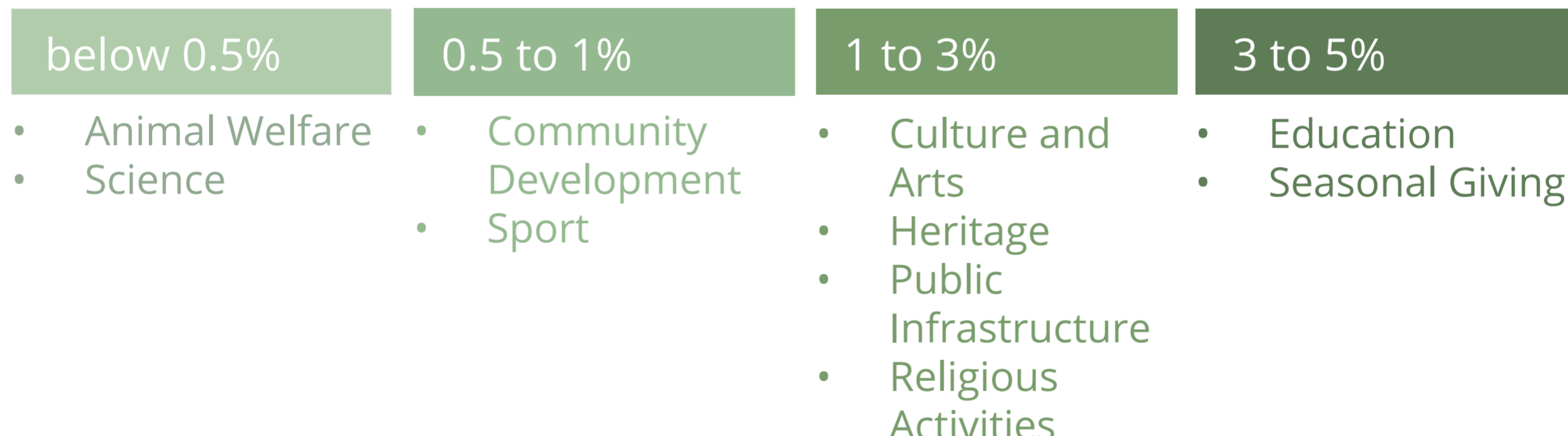
DONATIONS BY TYPE OF DONORS (% of instances vs. % of recorded sum)



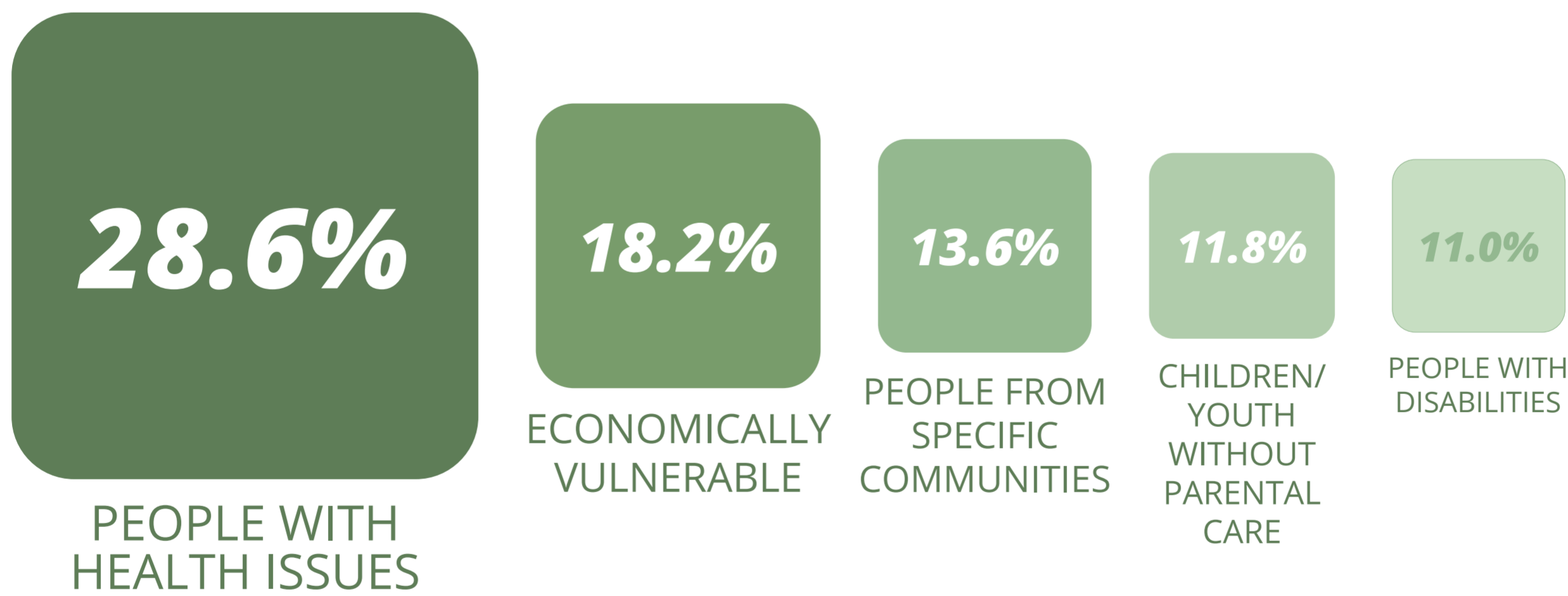
## KEY THEMES FOR GIVING



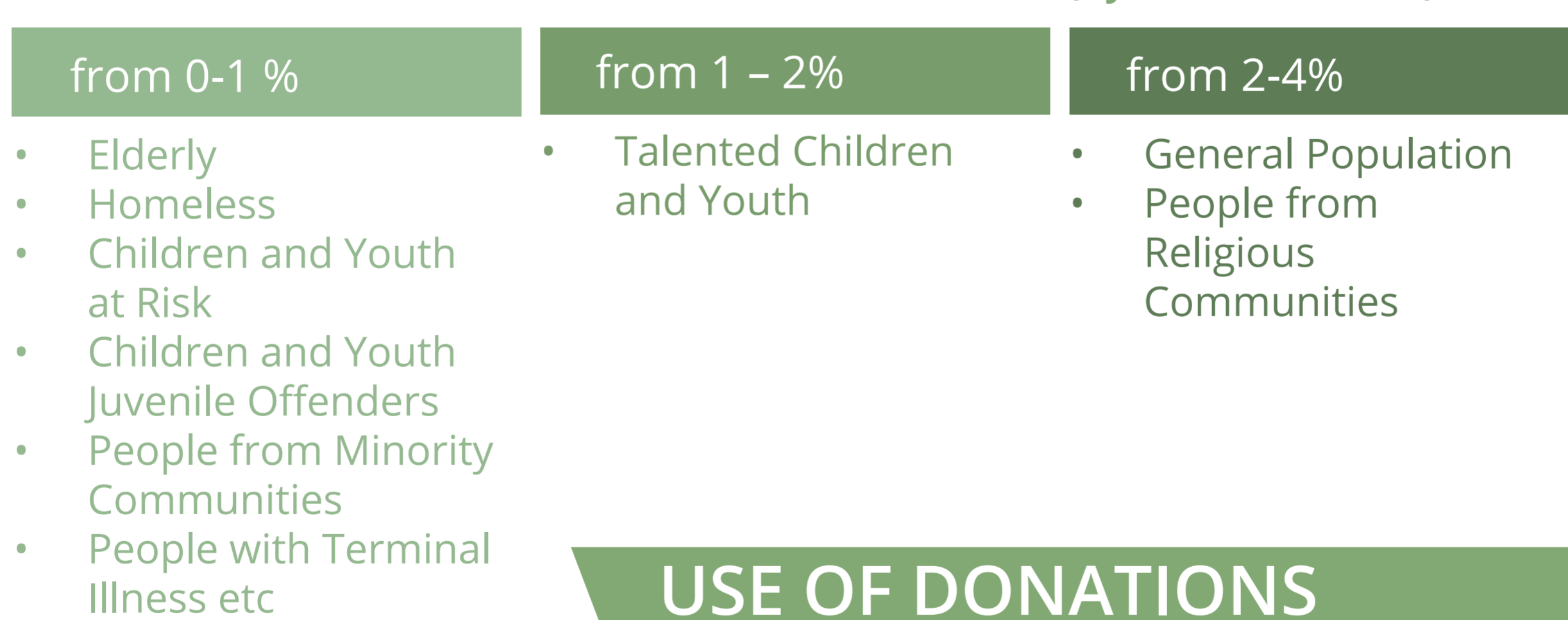
BREAKDOWN OF OTHER THEMES (% of Instances)



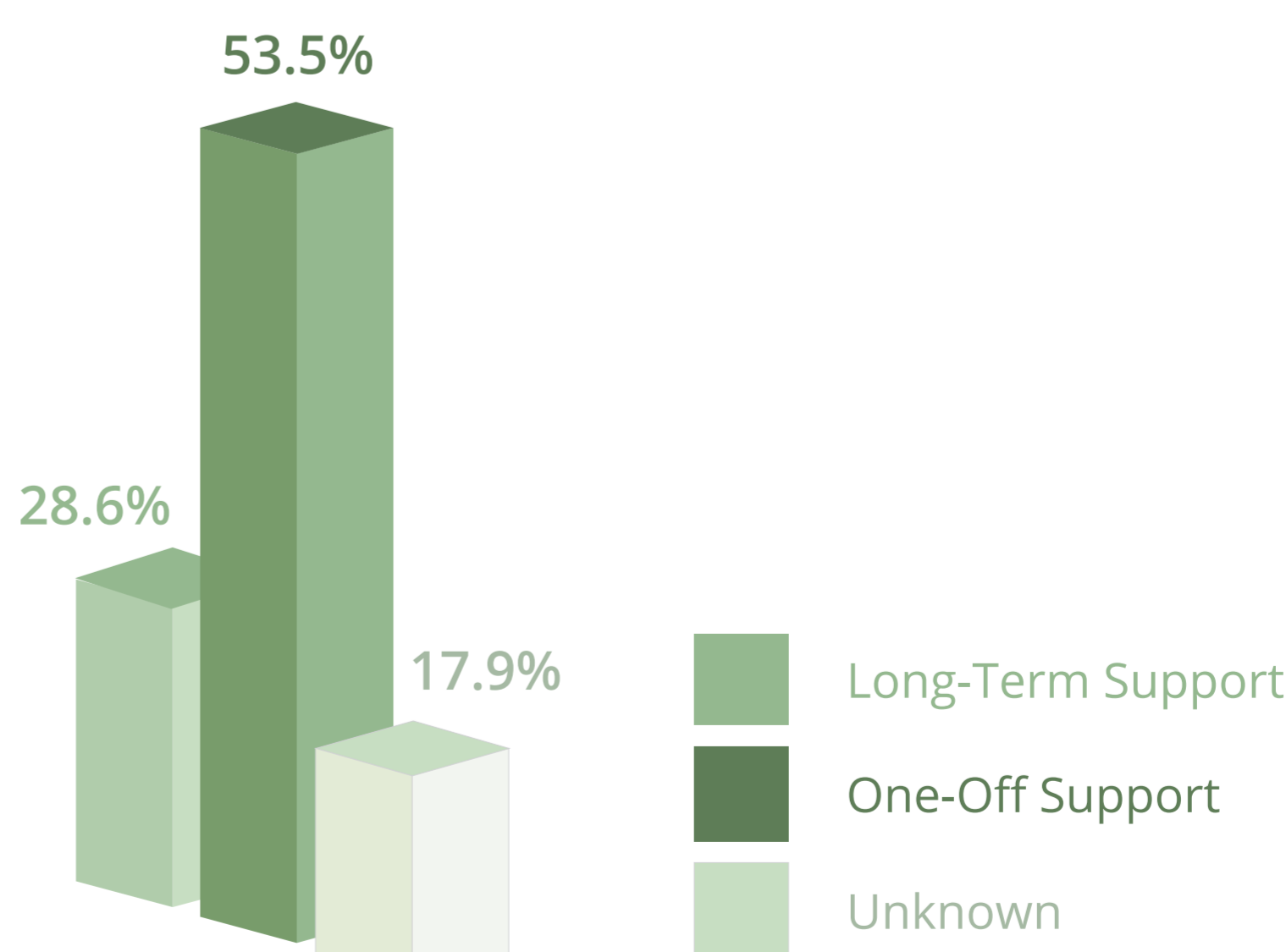
## RECIPIENTS OF DONATIONS
